Credits taken will be reflected on the official UMN transcript as a block of **transfer credit**, which will not be factored into the overall UMN GPA. Students will be able to see individual courses and grades on the APAS report. Grades from the host university that are equivalent to a 'D' grade at the UMN will be considered a passing grade and reflected in the total transfer credit and on the APAS report. 'D' grades will not count towards major requirements.

70 – 84 (Good/Very Good)	T
60-69 (Almost Good/Fair)	T
40 - 59 (Almost Fair/Poor)	D
0 – 39 (Failed)	F

***Credit Conversion:** 3 BBA Thammasat credit points = 3 UMN credits

***Carlson Minimum Credit Requirement:** 12 UMN equivalent credits per semester
